COMPETITION RULES & GUIDELINES

DESCRIPTION OF TERMS & COMPETITION BY GROUP:

- * **DXMC** - Drum, Xylophone, & Majorette Corps Competition
- * **BSP** - Boy Scouts of the Philippines Parade and Competition
- * **GSP** - Girl Scouts of the Philippines Parade and Competition
- * **Steering Committee** - the 2026 Regional Inter-School Scouts and DXMC Parade and Competition

SECTION I. PARTICIPATION. – The competition is open to any Public and Private Elementary & Junior High Schools and Senior High Schools in the Bicol Region.

SECTION II. CATEGORIES & COMPOSITION. – In each competing group, every category must have the following composition of participants, to wit:

- A. DXMC** - Naga City Public Schools Category A (small & medium schools; 35 - 50 members)
Category B (big schools; 50 members and above)
Category C (high schools; 50 members & above)
- Public Schools Outside Naga City, Private Schools of Naga City & Private Schools Outside Naga City Category D (elementary; 50 members & above)
- Public Schools Outside Naga City, Private Schools of Naga City & Private Schools Outside Naga City Category E (high schools; 50 members & above)
- B. BSP** - Kid Scouts Category (official uniform) 15 to 25 members
- *Must be composed of not less than thirty-two (32) scouts*
- Kab Scouts Category A (type “A” uniform)
Kab Scouts Category B (type “B” uniform)
Kab Scouts Category C (type “C” uniform)
Boy Scouts Category A (type “A” uniform)
Boy Scouts Category B (type “B” uniform)
Boy Scouts Category C (type “C” uniform)
Senior Scouts Category A (High School – JHS/SHS, type “A” uniform)
Senior Scouts Category B (High School – JHS/SHS, type “B” uniform)
Rover Scouts Category A (Inside Naga City – Rover Scouts – SHS)
Rover Scouts Category B (Outside Naga City – Rover Scouts – SHS)
- C. GSP** - Category A (Small School - Twinkler, Star, Junior)
Category B (Medium School - Twinkler, Star, Junior)
Category C (Big & Private Schools - Twinkler, Star, Junior)
Category D (Senior Scouts – JHS/SHS)
Category E (Outside Naga – Senior Scouts – JHS/SHS)

*(Twinkler 15-24 girls per troop; Star 36-40 girls per troop; Junior 36-40 girls per troop; Senior 36-40 girls per troop)

SECTION III. COMPETITION DATE AND ASSEMBLY POINT. – The 2026 Regional Inter-School Scouts and DXMC Parade and Competition will be held on Wednesday, September 16,

2026, from 6:00 a.m. onwards. The assembly area will be the stretch of Panganiban Drive and all participating contingents, whether competing or not, shall be at the assembly area on or before their assigned reporting time.

The parade will officially start at 7:00 a.m. Tardiness will merit an automatic one (1) point deduction from the total score in the score sheet of each of the judges and once the parade has started, no insertions by the late coming group/s are allowed. ***Provided that the tally sheets to be filled-out by the Committee's Marshall assigned to monitor the arrival/reporting time of participating contingents and to count the exact number of participants should bear the signature or conformity of the school coordinator or troop leader of all the participating contingents.*** Late contingents shall be designated to occupy the last part of the parade. The Order of the Parade will be determined and finalized by the **Committee** with the **coordinators of DXMC, BSP, & GSP.**

SECTION IV. RULES AND GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS. – All the participating contingents should strictly follow the following rules & guidelines and general instructions, to wit:

- a. Only registered Boy & Girl Scouts for the SY 2026-2027 can join the parade and competition. Participants must be officially enrolled in the school they represent;
- b. All competing troops (BSP & GSP) must be accompanied by their troop leaders, and they should be wearing their official uniform;
- c. Competing contingents shall adhere to the Order of Parade so as not to create confusion for the Board of Judges and the Masters of Ceremonies.
- d. Discipline at the assembly area and parade route shall be observed and troop leaders are required to follow the instructions of those in-charge of the Order of Parade. The Kabalikat 645 Naga Central is the official communication group designated to control the Order of Parade and provide necessary assistance to all participating contingents. Contingents including the parents, and their support staff should observe order and discipline starting from the assembly area up to the Plaza Quezon and for this purpose the “Most Disciplined Contingent/School Award” shall be given during the awarding ceremonies. Kids and Twinkler Scouts assembly area and entry point shall be the Penafrancia St. Extension (between May Bank and Mercury Drugs);
- e. Parents should not be allowed to stay in front of the stage or in the restricted area/space reserved for participating contingents in the duration of the competition. Schools may designate official photographers and official identification card shall be provided for them by the steering or organizing committee;
- f. The competition shall start with the 7:00 a.m. flag raising ceremony at the Plaza Quezon which will be attended by the city & DepEd officials including the DXMC, BSP, & GSP officials. A short program will follow with messages from the City Mayor and the Schools Division Superintendents of all participating divisions. Next in the program are the introduction of the Board of Judges and the presentation of the criteria for judging. Guests and officials shall be acknowledged during the program and competition proper, and the Rules & General Instructions maybe also explained by the Masters of Ceremonies;
- g. Only the city & DepEd officials, the DXMC, BSP, GSP officials and staff, guests, members of the Board of Judges, and the official tabulators will be allowed to occupy the stage of Plaza Quezon;
- h. The lead group of each competing unit shall be the DXMC followed by the BSP and GSP contingents. All exhibition performances by DXMC competing units shall wait on the side of the Crown Hotel (w/ Contingent Number Bearer positioned in front of Quality Café) and shall perform after all competing categories for the parade have passed. The next competing unit shall enter the Plaza Quezon Quadrangle if it is completely vacated and until an instruction to proceed is given by the Master of Ceremonies;
- i. For the DXMC Exhibition, performance time shall **not exceed seven (7) minutes** (entrance to exit). Excess of time will merit an automatic one (1) point deduction from the total score in the score sheet of each of the judges. Recording of the time of the performance shall start from the first beat of the sound up to the last beat. A timer officially designated by the steering committee shall be assigned to monitor the time of performances of contingents. The use of props is optional.

All instruments shall be carried by the participants from the start of the parade until performance time. No additional musical instruments shall be added near the Plaza Quezon before and during the performance. Electronic instruments are prohibited;

- j. The **Best Band Leader** and the **Best Drum and Xylophone Corps** shall be awarded to the school with the highest score in Drum and Xylophone Corps Competition. Similarly, the **Best Majorette Leader** and the **Best Majorette Corps** shall be awarded to the school with the highest score in Majorette Corps Competition;
- k. Winners of all categories in every group (DXMC, BSP, GSP) shall receive the same cash amount, trophy, and certificates. For categories with less than Three (3) participants, the participating contingent/s will receive Five Thousand (5,000.00) Pesos. The Naga City Government will finance the cash prizes, trophies, plaques, and certificates for the competition;
- l. Prizes may be claimed by the DXMC, BSP, & GSP school coordinators. Authorized representative of the school can also claim the winning prize if he/she has a written authority signed by the principal or the coordinator;
- m. School administrators and DXMC, BSP, GSP coordinators must ensure that the cash prizes will be enjoyed by the school children who participated in the parade and competition;
- n. The criteria for judging, selection of the Board of Judges and their accommodation, and the tabulation of results and the certification of official winners of the competition shall be the responsibility of the coordinators of DXMC, BSP, & GSP;
- o. Judges shall not come from the participating DepEd Divisions;
- p. It is a rain or shine event, but the safety of the schoolchildren and other participants is still the top priority. The Chairman in consultation with the City Mayor has the final say whether to proceed or not with the competition in case/s of unfavorable or extreme weather condition.

SECTION V. PRIZES.—At stake are the following major prizes:

A. DXMC COMPETITION (CATEGORY A)

D. The special awards to be awarded are:

* BEST BAND LEADER (Category A to F)	- trophy plus certificate
* BEST MAJORETTE LEADER (Category A to F)	- trophy plus certificate
* BEST MAJORETTE CORPS (Category A to F)	- trophy plus certificate
* BEST DRUM & XYLOPHONE CORPS (Category A to F)	- trophy plus certificate
* MOST DISCIPLINED SCHOOL AWARD	- trophy plus certificate

**Coordinators honoraria of one thousand five hundred pesos (P1,500.00) will be given to all competing schools. Coordinators are required to attend the final meeting and the drawing of lots.*

**In case there are less than 3 participants in a category, the participating schools receive P5,000.00 as participation incentive.*

SECTION VI. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING. – The following are the criteria for judging in each group.

1. DRUM & XYLOPHONE CORPS (60% of TOTAL SCORE)

A.	MASTERY, DEXTERITY, RHYTHM, TIMBRE <i>(precision, unity, clarity, and tone quality)</i>	25%
B.	MUSICAL PIECE <i>(melody, tempo, dynamics, style, phrasing, texture, & harmony)</i>	25%
C.	CHOREOGRAPHY <i>(style, smartness, timing, & marching)</i>	25%
D.	UNIFORM <i>(style, appropriateness, & neatness of attire)</i>	15%
E.	GENERAL IMPACT <i>(deportment, performance of leader, salute, entrance & exit)</i>	10%

MAJORETTE CORPS (40% OF TOTAL SCORE)		
A.	TECHNIQUE IN BATON TWIRLING <i>(fluidity of movements, dexterity w/ props, & precision)</i>	25%
B.	MOVEMENT AND STYLE <i>(appropriateness and complexity of movements/steps)</i>	25%
C.	CHOREOGRAPHY <i>(coordination, formation, and use of space)</i>	25%
D.	UNIFORM <i>(style, appropriateness, & neatness of attire)</i>	15%
E.	GENERAL IMPACT <i>(deportment, performance of leader, salute, entrance & exit)</i>	10%

C.	SMARTNESS <i>(Uniformity – 20 points; posture – 10 points)</i>	30 points

B.	UNIFORM – GIRLS & TROOP LEADERS	40%
C.	CADENCE	20%
D.	EYES RIGHT	15%

NOTE:

- Judges may not give a grade lower than half of the allotted points for each criterion.
- Other cases of violation of the rules but not specified in the Sections mentioned above shall be determined in consensus by the Board of Judges.

- SECTION VII.** **SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES.** – The submission of the entries/commitment/conforme form will be through Google Online Forms link which will be provided through the Naga City Government Facebook Page. All entries must be submitted be Friday, September 4, 2026 (2:00 p.m.). A final meeting and drawing of lots will be conducted on September 4, 2026, 2 p.m. at the SP Session Hall, City Hall, City of Naga.
- SECTION VIII.** **DECISION.** – The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
- SECTION IX.** **ORIENTATION/FINAL BRIEFING.** – A meeting, if needed, will be called upon by the respective coordinators of DXMC, BSP, & GSP to discuss important preparation of the competition and to also address concerns of the participating divisions and contingents. All coordinators are required to render reports on updates and preparation in the meeting of the steering committee.
